For the 1972-1973 MASTERS PROGRAM

Iran Center for Management Studies (ICMS) is an independent graduate school of management, governed by a Board of Trustees whose members have been appointed by Royal Decree and established in cooperation with Harvard Business School. Below is a brief description of the Masters Program and the Admission Procedure.

- The language of instruction is English.
- Length of the Program is eleven months. The first Masters Program begins in October of 1972 and ends in August of 1973.
- The ICMS Masters Program is intensive and residential. The amount of time necessary for individual and group study is between twelve to fourteen hours per day. Therefore, no student can hold a job for the duration of the program and all unenrolled students are required to live in the living quarters on campus.
- The curriculum is practitioner-oriented and the principle method of teaching is the case method. ICMS believes that the most important attribute of an administrator is judgement and that judgement can be developed only through practice. Therefore, from the outset students at ICMS discuss cases i.e., description of real administrative situation in which executives take action and are responsible for the results.
- The ICMS faculty is chosen with the same standards as that of the Harvard Business School and will include members of the Harvard Business School faculty, as well as Harvard trained Iranian professors.

Because of the low student to faculty ratio (7 to 1) and a small student body (about 60), actual cost of operating the school is estimated at 650,000 Rials per student. Since a major portion of the cost will be covered by the income of an endowment fund, students applying individually will be expected to cover only a sixth of the cost or 100,000 Rials for the eleven-month academic year. Companies presenting participants shall be expected to bear less than half of the actual cost or 300,000 Rials.

Total cost per student, therefore, will be as follows:

Individuals may pay their expenses and fees in four installments.

7. It is a basic policy of ICMS that no qualified student from Iran shall be denied entrance because of lack of funds. To this end, ICMS offers two categories of Financial Aid: a loan program (two year repayment after leaving ICMS at low interest rate) and a scholarship program.

8. It is important to note that the Admissions Board will process admission applications without reference to the applicants' ability to afford ICMS expenses.

9. The Admission Prerequisites are as follows:

- A Bachelor's degree - no particular field is preferred. (Those with two or more years of experience will be given preference).
- Ability to speak and write English fluently.
- Exemption from military service or eligibility for student deferment (for Iranian students).

10. In addition to completing the application forms and providing ICMS with the appropriate data, all applicants are required to take the Admission Test for Graduate Study in Business (ATGSB) administered by the Educational Testing Service, Princeton, New Jersey. In 1971 the test will be given on November 6th. This test is given at many educational centers all over the world including the Community School in Tehran. Test applications must be filed directly with Educational Testing Service before September 24th, 1971.

11. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Eligible candidates may follow the procedure outlined below:

- Complete the perforated portion of this notice.
- Deposit an application fee of 1,000 Rials in Iran Center for Management Studies' Account No. 78180 at any branch of Bank Mellি Iran. This application fee is non-refundable.
- Mail in the application request form along with the bank receipt of the application fee to: Iran Center for Management Studies P.O. Box No. 11-1573, Tehran.
